Reports, above all on Risk • Impressive dialogue and working group results • Education in core • Quality of work • Value = seniority and geographical representation • More dialogue in between the Symposia • Education or think tank, or what else? • ISSA had lost its way and found it again • Infrastructure and FIMs can work together and discuss – seems the only organisation that brings both together • Is ISSA a research organisation or should it have teeth? • Work with other industry associations but do not duplicate 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Role of Collateral – how will increased demand impact the industry and implications for ISSA constituents? • "Sell" the Working Group reports beyond the Symposium attendees and ISSA members • New subjects, like "Non-Network Assets" and "Collateral – narrowed down to specific issues" • Risk Reduction, such as "Security of Collateral" or "CCP interoperability" • Contractual templates along the lines of the ISLA document, covering the links resp. handovers between members of the chain • Have the Operating Committee assume more of a coordination role (rather than doing detailed work) • Transform reports into next steps, i.e. Best Practices • Leverage work of Working Group 2 (Risks) on CPSS IOSCO Standards • Stay away from regional discussions and focus on global issues
