Review of the last minutes and actions

Action 1. Brett had received the documentation from KSD and he and Colin will look at it. Strate Booked for Monday.

Action 2. Still awaiting documentation. Re-emphasized that if confidential send to Colin only and he will blend with other input to ensure that there is no data leakage that can be attributed to a single firm. PLEASE send Colin your firm's requested data.

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Action 3. Good progress most interviews have been had and only need to be written up.

Commonality of status and issues:

- a. Onboarding not firm wide priority compared to reg change etc.
- b. Everyone wants transparency (both client and onboarder)
- c. Lots of fintech's but none end to end
- d. Everyone has pushed the fintech's and themselves to do more but the problems persist.
- e. Standards including Definitions would help (things like Wolfsberg principles have helped in setting base level standards)
- f. A firms' history effect their requirements and then particular nuances (e.g. home regulatory requirements) affect what they need too.
- g. Clear words needed rather than a vernacular
- h. Little integration
- i. Opportunity to mutualize but no appetite
- j. Technology solutions better in EM as they build 4G without ever having a landline
- k. SIFMA, ACG and AFME all have views (not always aligned)
- I. Al hoped to be a solution
- m. Blockchain repeatedly quoted as potential solution.

We will use these to create our solutions paper. SPB will create a skeleton paper and syndicate and we will push to have this ready for review week 11th Dec. We should additionally work on a KYC matrix which shows scenarios i.e. AM trading EM Bonds in Brazil needs A, B, C, D and E

IM trading Brazilian FX needs A,C, C,E, F, G and H this should establish the super set of requirements (do not go too deep!)

SWIFT Standards group offered to help in the learnings about trying to establish standards.
