


ISSA Symposium 2025

Key Deliverables

Remote Network Due Diligence

- Industry Recommendations published (see here)
- Engage with AFME, WFC and ACG on collaboration to simplify the processes in line with the recommendations. Carried forward to 2025

Managing Change from a CSD Perspective

- Publish a paper recommending a framework to effect change with minimal operational disruption and avoiding unintended consequence
- Provide best practice guidance for rules, systems and process

Key Deliverables (cont.)

Mutualised Market Solutions

- Publish a paper analyzing the feasibility of leveraging mutualised technologies and proposing potential models for consideration
